


Install *DataManager* App

This QRG is for users who will add the *DataManager* application to individual Chromebook devices. For managed installations, see *Installing the DataManager Chromebook Application (Managed Solution)*.



Step 1
In a Chrome browser, navigate to <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/detail/datamanager/gngadipbljmmcgjfflidckpbgebnd>


Step 2
Click **Add to Chrome**. A dialog box displays asking you to confirm the installation.

Step 3
Click **Add**. Chrome installs the app.

Did You Know?
Google Chromebook OS version 44 beta is required for the *DataManager* app to function correctly. If you are using a previous version, then you must update your OS before installing the *DataManager* app.

Note: Do **not** launch the app before managing Chrome extensions.

Manage Extensions



Step 1
In a Chrome browser, navigate to *chrome://extensions*.

Step 2
Select **Developer mode**.

Step 3
Select and copy the *DataManager* application ID.

Step 4
Click **Manage kiosk applications...**
The **Manage Kiosk Applications** dialog displays.

Step 5
Paste in the application ID.

Step 6
Click **Add**, and then click **Done**. You will need to restart the device before launching the app.

Note: You may need to scroll down to view Kiosk Settings.

Did You Know?
To launch the app in Kiosk Mode from the login page, click the **Apps** menu and then click the *DataManager* icon.
To launch the app in Non-Kiosk Mode from the login page, type the password for the Chromebook user account. Click the **Apps** menu and then click the *DataManager* icon.
